[] Revolutionary Discipleship: Growing in Spiritual Maturity - PM 102 (1.5 credits)

Term 1, Monday Brisbane 7:00-8:00pm, 8 weeks (begins 30 Jan)

What does it mean to be a disciple of Jesus? How do I disciple others? How can I grow in spiritual maturity? These questions and others will be answered in the Revolutionary Discipleship class. You will be inspired to leave spiritual immaturity and go on to the fullness of God's plan for your life. Be prepared to be challenged, convicted and rooted deeply in your faith. Then be ready to reproduce yourself in others and multiply the Kingdom.

[] The Life & Heart of David - OT 104 (1.5 credits)

Term 1, Monday, 8:15-9:30pm, 8 weeks (begins 30 Jan)

David, the once neglected boy who rose to become King of Judah is one of the most important figures in human history. Out his family line the Messiah came. There was something about this man that captured the heart of God, causing the Lord to describe him as "a man after my own heart." In this course we will focus on the period of Israel's Monarchical history of Prophets, Priests and Kings with a special focus on King David's life and heart.

[] Knowing God & His Ways - TH 102 (1.5 credits)

Term 2, Monday 7:00– 8:00pm, 8 weeks (begins 10 Apr)

Knowing God is the most important aspect of our life and ministry. This class will increase your knowledge of God, both intellectually and experientially. It will cover the attributes, nature and character of God. It will teach you to worship God for who He is – in Spirit and in Truth. As A.W. Tozer wrote, "The heaviest obligation lying upon the Christian Church today is to purify and elevate her concept of God until it is once more worthy of Him—and of her [the church]."

[] Growing in Holiness - CH 101 (1.5 credits)

Term 2, Monday 8:15-9:30pm, 8 weeks (begins 10 Apr)

Holiness is one of the most neglected subjects of God's people. This subject will help recover the lost teaching of holiness in the Scripture. We will discover the true meaning of holiness, as well as learn false teachings on holiness. Such topics as the difference between holiness

and legalism, and the true meaning of grace will be covered. As Robert Murray McCheyne (1813-1843) once said, "A holy minister is an awful [awesome] weapon in the hand of God."

[] Engaging with God: Spiritual Formation – PM102L (1.5 credits)

Term 1, Thursday, 6:30– 7:15pm, 8 weeks (begins 2 Feb)

Setting our hearts on pilgrimage with God is one of the greatest joys of discovery we can enter into. In our desire to grow in relationship with God, the true disciple will commit themselves to deeper levels of engagement in order to better know the Father's heart. In this subject students will have the opportunity to encounter God in fresh new ways in plumbing the deeper depths, higher heights, wider widths and longer lengths of the Father's love for them.

[] The Life of King David – OT104 (1.5 credits)

Term 1, Thursday 7:40-8:20pm, 8 weeks (begins 2 Feb)

David, the once neglected boy who rose to become King of Judah is one of the most important people in human history for it was out his family line, the Messiah Jesus would come from. While a great king, David was not without his faults. But there was something about this man that captured the heart of God, causing Him to describe him as "A man after my own heart." In this course we will focus on the period of Israel's Monarchical history of Prophets, Priests and Kings with a special focus on King David's life, rise to power, and reign as King of Judah.

[] Pursuing Holiness – CH101 (1.5 credits)

Term 2, Thursday 6:30-7:15pm, 8 weeks (begins 12 Apr)

"Be holy, for I am Holy" (1 Pt. 1:16; Lev. 11:44). One of God's core characteristics is holiness. His desire for us as His children is to reflect this aspect of His nature to all of creation. Here students will engage with the writings of A.W Tozer through reading and discussing his classic devotional, "The Pursuit of Holiness" as we seek to fulfill this desire of the Lord's heart to be and learn to become more like Him.

[] Revival in the South Pacific – HI101L (1.5 credits)

Term 2, Thursday 7:40-8:20pm, 8 weeks (begins 12 Apr)

Australia and the surrounding islands of the South Pacific have been labeled as the Great Southland of the Holy Spirit. Revival and awakening has broken out on numerous times in this region in history and these moves of God are the focus of this subject. In doing so we will lay a platform for God to do it again. "We have heard of your deeds O Lord. Renew them in our day!" (Hab. 3:2).
